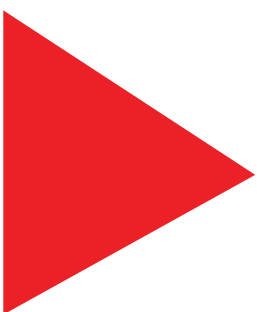

They are strategically positioned above or near exit doors, stairwells and escape routes to provide clear guidance to individuals seeking a safe exit. These signs

play a critical role in reducing panic, minimizing confusion and facilitating efficient evacuation procedures. By clearly marking emergency exits and providing a reliable means of egress, emergency exit signs contribute to the overall safety and well-being of occupants in emergency situations, allowing for swift and orderly evacuations and potentially saving lives.
